AMERICANS HAVE A LOT TO ANSWER FOR

We are all human beings made by God. He made us to know Him, to love Him, and to serve Him. He even gave us the Ten Commandments to follow so we could stay on the right track in order to reach Heaven and Him. But have we? No, we have not. The Fifth Commandment is “Thou Shall Not kill”. Yet almost every day there is a report in the newspapers or on TV news of someone being killed or of a mass murder that took place in one of our cities.

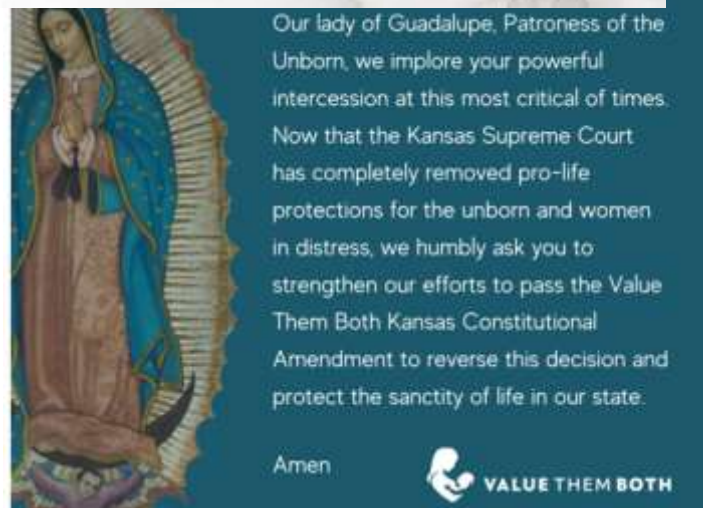
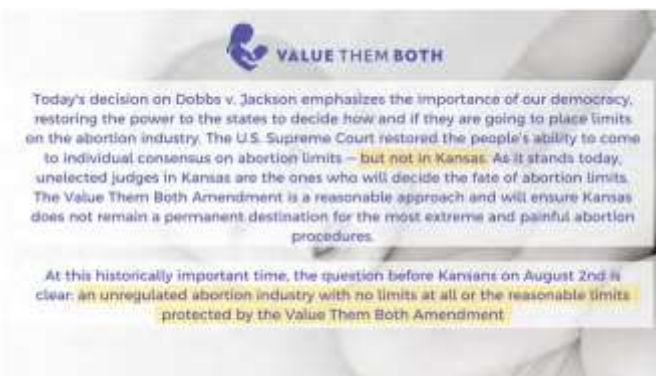
