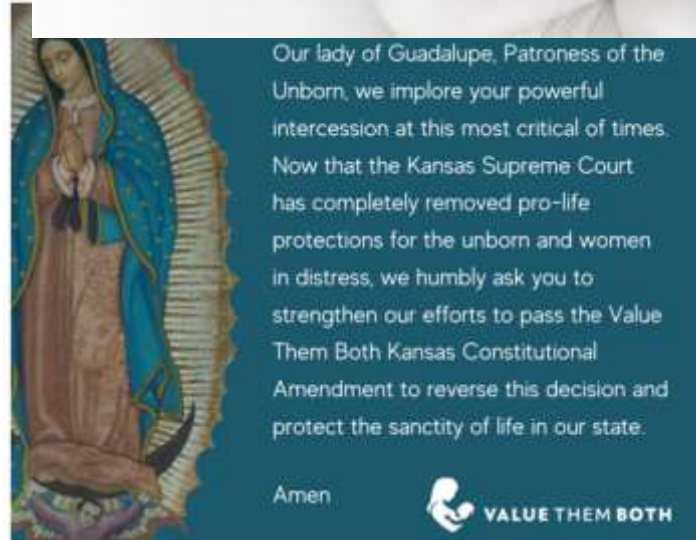
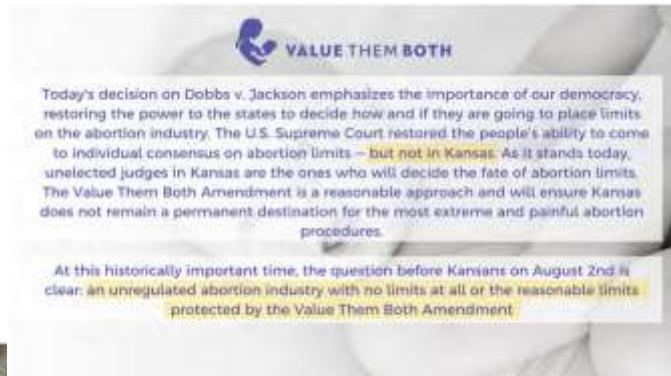
Further criteria require the applicant to be a Native Born Resident of the United States, a Catholic, and have been a member of the National Fertility Regulation Program for at least one year.
