LOCAL BLACK CATHOLIC

HISTORY. Since it is Black History Month, I want to honor the great and impactful history of Holy Epiphany Parish. It was established by Leavenworth's Bishop Louis Fink in 1874— the first black Catholic parish established west of the Mississippi River. The church, rectory, school and convent were located at 7th & Pottawatomie (at the site of the former June's). The school was originally staffed by the Sisters of Charity, but in 1888 the Oblate Sisters of Providence, a Black order of Sisters from Baltimore came and maintained not only their grade school (and for a while a high school), but two orphanages for Black children, one for boys and the other for girls. Their founding pastor, Fr. Martin Kuhn was very devoted to his ministry, as well as was Monsignor Shorter and the legendary and much beloved Father Matthew Guifoyle. I received a call about month ago from an elderly gentleman who grew up in the orphanage, and he told me Father Guifoyle treated him like a son. This man lives in Colorado and will be making a trip back this way soon, and I look forward to meeting him and listening to his story. The school and the parish closed in 1954— Father Tom Culhane was their last pastor. God bless all those who were part of
