URGENT: FOOD PANTRY. I hope you all received my email last week about the serious shortage of food at our Catholic Charities Food Pantry in Leavenworth. Our own parish's weekly collection of food is needed more than ever. Ongoing pantry needs are: peanut butter and jelly, cans or plastic containers of fruit juice, canned fruits and vegetables, small bags of pinto beans, black beans, rice or barley, powdered milk, spaghetti sauce and tomato sauce. They also need oatmeal, cereals, breads, pastas, crackers and tortillas, canned meats and fish, soups and boxed dinners. If you donate pancake mix please consider donating syrup as well. Also in need are personal hygiene items.

You may continue to leave your non-perishable items in the bin in our church vestibules and they will be delivered to Catholic Charities. Thanks for performing this important corporal work of mercy.
