A GOSPEL THOUGHT. The Risen Jesus appears physically to His disciples, inviting them to touch his hands and feet to verify his reality. He eats with them, demonstrating his tangible presence after His resurrection. This passage emphasizes that Christ is not merely a distant figure of history and myth, but a living, substantial presence in our lives today. It challenges us to seek and encounter Him not only in the Eucharist but also in ordinary moments, knowing that He is truly with us always and everywhere.

Making the Mass More Meaningful:

Be reverent. As we come inside the church we are around people we know. Of course we smile and greet them, but do so very quietly and briefly. You can visit after Mass. Be considerate to those who are quietly and prayerfully preparing for Mass. Keep in mind that we are in the presence of Christ, and let's honor the atmosphere of reverence that our Church tradition encourages.
