Catholics 14 and over abstain from meat on Lenten Fridays as an act of penance, remembering Christ's passion on Good Friday and uniting with His sacrifice for our salvation.

A MISCONCEPTION EXISTS that only priests can touch the Host and distribute Communion. In fact, at Mass, trained and authorized laypeople, called Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, can assist the priest in distributing the Eucharist. While only a priest can consecrate the bread and wine, this practice, approved by the Vatican in 1973, ensures that Communion is distributed in a timely manner and also brought to the sick and homebound. The key is that the minister is properly trained and authorized by the Church. Ultimately, receiving Holy Communion is about receiving Christ, not focusing on the minister.
