**PLEASE NOTE:** Beginning this weekend, we are reviewing our procedure for receiving Holy Communion:

**Approach reverently** – Walk forward with a spirit of prayer and reverence, recognizing the sacredness of the moment.

**Make a bow of reverence** – Before receiving the Eucharist, bow as a sign of respect for the Real Presence of Christ.

**IF YOU CHOSE TO RECEIVE  
COMMUNION ON THE TONGUE:**

Stand still with a steady posture, keeping your hands folded. Open your mouth wide enough, and extend your tongue so the priest or minister can place the Host smoothly and reverently.

**IF YOU CHOSE TO RECEIVE  
COMMUNION IN THE HAND:**

Place one hand flat over the other, forming a throne to receive the Host. If you are right-handed, place your left hand on top; if left-handed, place your right hand on top. **Consume the Host immediately** – Take the Host with your lower hand and place it in your mouth **without stepping to the side**. Do not walk away before consuming the Host first.

**Receive the Host with faith** – When the minister says, "The Body of Christ," respond clearly, "**Amen**," as a profession of belief.

**Return to your pew in prayer** – After receiving, return to your seat and
